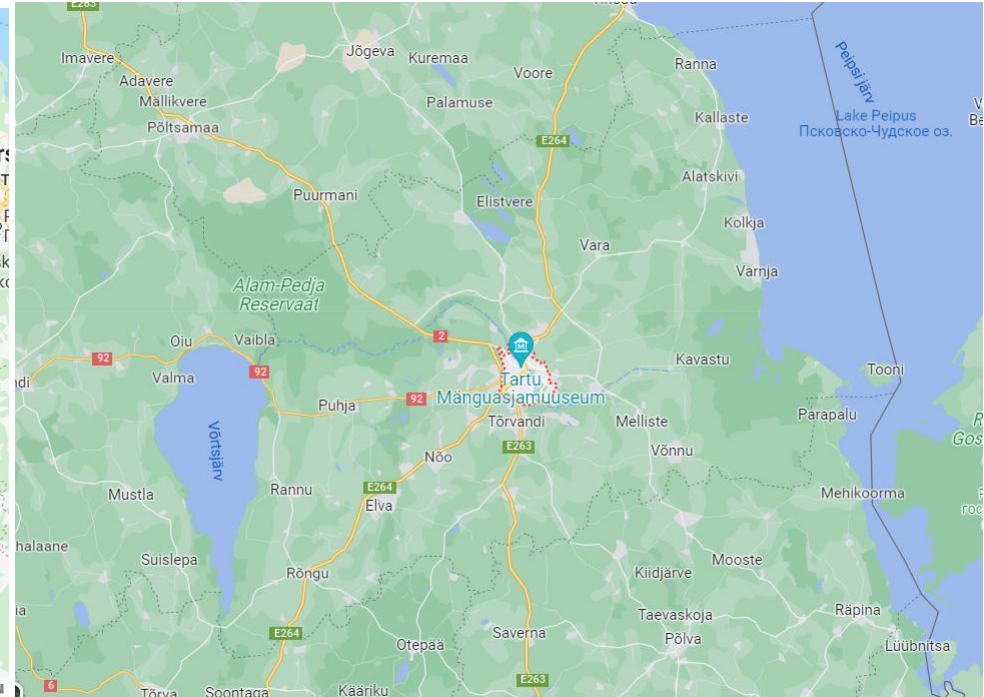

## TARTU

**Tartu** is the second largest city in [Estonia](#). Tartu has a population of 91,407 (as of 2021). It is 186 kilometres (116 miles) southeast of Tallinn (the capital) and 245 kilometres (152 miles) northeast of Riga, Latvia. Tartu lies on the [Emajõgi](#) river, which connects the two largest lakes in Estonia, [Lake Võrtsjärv](#) and [Lake Peipus](#). Tartu is easily accessible by car, train, or bus. Tartu will be the European Capital of Culture in 2024.



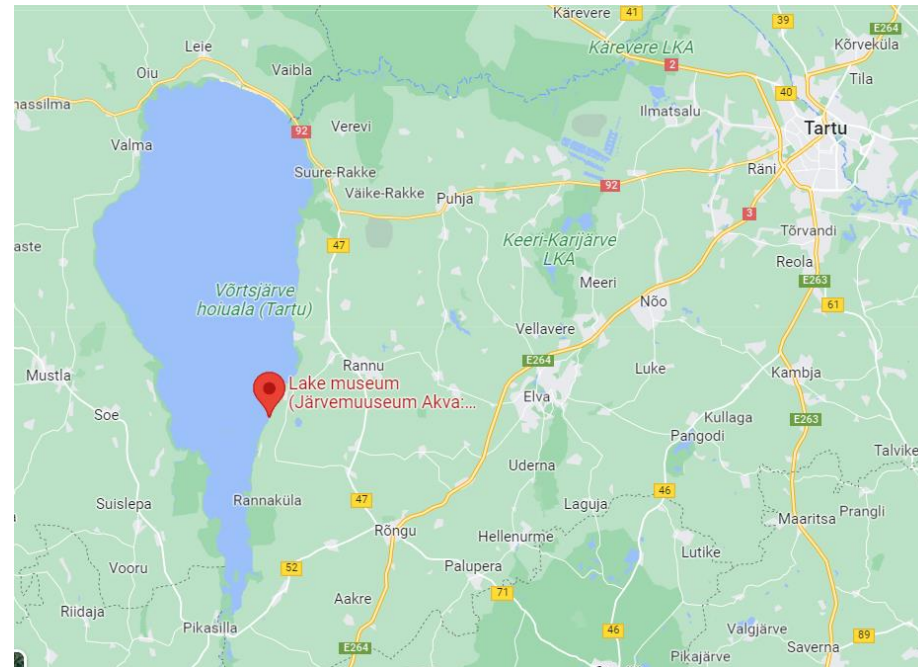

## EVENT VENUE

Lake Võrtsjärv (270 km<sup>2</sup>, catchment area 3374 km<sup>2</sup>) in South Estonia is the second largest lake in Baltic countries and the largest lake within the boundaries of Estonia. It is a shallow and turbid eutrophic lake with a mean depth of 2.8 m and maximum depth of 6 m. The water level changes with annual mean amplitude 1.4 m, and this, together with winds, is the main factor influencing the biota in the lake. Võrtsjärv is covered with ice on average 130 days a year (from the end of November till April). The competition sectors will be located on the eastern shore of the lake. The venue locates 45 km from the competition centre.

## Fish and fishing Information – Lake Võrtsjärv

According to current data, 31 fish species permanently inhabit L. Võrtsjärv (Pihu, 1998; Järvalt et al, 2003). The main commercial fishes are eel, pikeperch, northern pike and bream, while perch, roach *Rutilus rutilus* (L.), ruffe *Gymnocephalus cernuus* (L.) and burbot are of secondary economic importance. L. Võrtsjärv has all the qualities characterizing a pikeperch lake, shallow, eutrophic, relatively warm and turbid in summer. Presence of vegetation in the lake (except in its southern part) is rather poor.

### Catch limits and minimum length

In Estonia it is forbidden to catch the following species, in the case of catching one of these species, the fish should be returned to water immediately:

- **Grayling** (*Thymallus thymallus*)
- **Asp** (*Leuciscus aspius*)
- **Catfish** (*Silurus glanis*)

The catch limit for **bream** (*Abramis brama*) is 15pcs per day. This should be followed on all training days, exception will be granted for competition days.

**Minimum length for pike** (*Esox lucius*) is 45cm, **eel** (*Anguilla anguilla*) 55cm, **tench** (*Tinca tinca*) 30cm, **zander** (*Sander lucioperca*) 51cm and **burbot** (*Lota lota*) 40cm.

**No fishing in the competition area on Lake Võrtsjärv from 11.2.2023. Fishing is permitted again from 22.2.2023.**

Training at the venue shall be forbidden for all Nations in the entire area chosen for the championship, as well as 500 metres around it.

## TEAM COMPOSITION

### Official Team Composition

- a maximum of 6 competitors (5 primary + 1 reserve)
- 2 Captains
- 1 Delegate

### Non – Official Team Support Personnel, Media and Others

Teams are allowed to bring additional support personnel, in addition to the Official Team.

### Participation fees

Registration fee is 1450 € per team (6 competitors, 2 captains, 1 delegate), which includes the FIPSeD fee of 150 € per team, the closing banquet, awards, 6 fishing permits etc. When registering for a championship, the Federations, in addition to the official members of the Delegation, will also be allowed to register extra people (up to a maximum of 3) who will be considered as belonging to the Delegation itself. The registration cost for each of these accompanying people will be € 100 of which € 75 will go to the organizers for the official banquet, insurance and any gadgets and € 25 will go to F.I.P.S.e.d. for the expenses related to the medal and diploma that will be delivered to the person in question in case of achievement of the podium by the federation to which he belongs.

Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process.
